

# Art'ssake



TURNING a blank wall into a statement is all in a day's work for Wanda James of Go Arty and she has just worked wonders on a whole house at Pelican Waters.

Owners Greg and Judy are absolutely thrilled with the result.

The couple only moved into their new, two-storey waterfront home one month ago and wanted it to feel like home 'as soon as we moved in'.

Judy said her builder recommended she visit Go Arty in Norval Court, Maroochydore, which has artwork and home wares in stock or can custom paint a piece to suit.

Judy chose five pieces of artwork and numerous home wares to match – including vases, statues and sculptural pieces.

She had the in-house artists paint the artworks in muted colours of steel, black and white with

splashes of green and orange, to specifically suit the décor of each room.

In the entrance, she commissioned a piece to match the cylindrical, spaceship-looking pendant light overhead and the result is a bold statement: fluid lines of black and silver flow across bubbles of green and tactile geometric features.

"People's likes are as important as their dislikes," explains Wanda.

"When we work with people, you have to get to know their personality and what they want and I feel we have really achieved that result here."

The artwork in the lounge-dining space is one of their favourites

– with its circular patterns and splashes of green and orange.

"We wanted the pieces ready to hang when we moved in," said Judy.
